The J.L. Summers Achievement Award

This award is presented annually to a member of the Branch in recognition of a significant contribution within the practice of hospital pharmacy, which demonstrates innovation and leadership in the health care field.

Please take the time to recognize the outstanding contributions of a fellow society member by nominating him/her for this award.

Betty C. Riddell Award for Pharmacy Practitioner Excellence

This award is presented annually to a member of the Branch in recognition of outstanding achievement to patient care, contribution to the profession and long term service to the practice of pharmacy (minimum 10 years). Selection of

nominees will be made on the basis of involvement and significant contribution to the practice of pharmacy at the pharmacist's work place.

Pharmacist of the Year Award

This award is presented annually to a member of the Branch in recognition of outstanding achievement to the practice of hospital pharmacy. The President-Elect, along with Branch Delegate, attends the National Annual General Meeting. This is a great opportunity to meet pharmacists from across the country, including the National Executive and some of the Office staff who assist them. The following year, the President-Elect assumes the position of President and represents Saskatchewan hospital pharmacists on various committees and at meetings throughout the province. The President-Elect attends all Executive Committee Meetings as a full voting member.

Educational Services Chair The incumbent in this position is responsible for the recruiting of committee members for the Educational Service Committee which plans the educational programs for the Annual and Regional Meetings, the Saskatchewan portion of the Banff Seminar, and the Saskatchewan Branch CSHP Regional Seminars. The ECS chair must hold at least three committee meetings during the year. The ECS chair will be a corresponding member of the National CSHP Educational Services Committee and serve as the Saskatchewan Branch representative and co-ordinator to the Banff Seminar. The former ECS chair will be available for the new ECS chair in the subsequent year for any problems/questions that may arise during planning of the AGM. The ECS chair attends all Executive Committee Meetings and the Branch Annual General Meeting.
